To know the Lord means that one will defend the cause of the poor and needy (Jer. 22:16). The renewed covenant is possible only because the Lord will forgive iniquity and not remember sin. SECOND READING: Romans 3:19-28 Paul's words stand at the heart of the preaching of Martin Luther and other Reformation leaders.
