### Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,



We are addicted to hurry. We rush around and do all the things we think we are expected to do and we fall into our beds exhausted at the end of the day, falling asleep as we begin to pray. We are addicted to being busy. It is a status symbol. It's almost as if we compare our calendars to see whose is the fullest of activities and appointments, as if our value were measured by how busy we are.

Even pastors like to complain to one another about how busy we are. Perhaps that helps us feel like our work is important-few other people seem to think so.

Kirk Byron Jones, professor of social ethics and pastoral ministry at Andover Newton Theological Seminary, wrote a book titled Addicted to Hurry. "When hurry becomes a chronic condition, when we run even when there is no reason to, when we rush while performing even the most mundane tasks, it may be said that we have become addicted to hurry. Thousands of us are addicted to hurry whether we admit it or not," writes Jones. As we hurry, we lose sight of those around us, of important experiences, of people, of our time with God.

Sunday mornings may be one more source of "hurry" in our lives. We hurry to get up, to clean up, to dress up, or to dress the kids, just to get to church. Then we hurry off to whatever other business we have before us.

But Sunday is the Christian Sabbath, the day of rest. We sit in the pews, we hear the Good News of Jesus, and we allow ourselves to be served. This is important to our health: Physical, mental, and spiritual. This is important to our lives. This is important to the end. Come and rest!


Remember, you are a Child of God. You are blessed, loved, and never alone, for your entire life!
