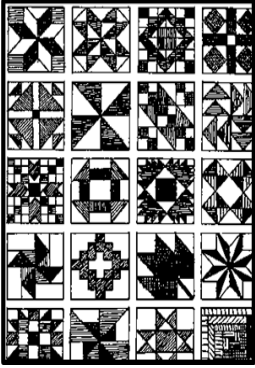

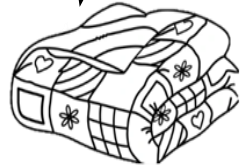

EAST Council Minutes: May 5, 2026

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order.

Members Present: Randy Robinson, Pastor Paul Thompson, Bryan DeCook, Gary Kearns, Jane Williams, Pete Exe, Terry Zieman, Jeff Beaver

Devotions: Pastor Paul

Guest Speaker: Bob Braaten: Bob discussed the needs for the parking lot to be updated, cracks filled and the lot sealed. He has gotten two bids, and one was chosen at \$1220. He proposed to gift that to the church. The work will be done sometime in late summer. Steve Paulson will be doing the work.

Pastor's Report: Pastor visited 7 shut-ins, 2 hospitalized, and 2 members. Confirmation is winding down. He attended the Synod Assembly with Pat Cahill. He discussed the issue of finding subs for Pastors, and the Synod is implementing two programs that train lay people to step in when a pastor cannot.

Secretary's Report: April minutes were read and approved.

Financial Secretary's Report: Bryan presented the financial statements.

Current Giving for April was \$4,670.00. This included Easter.

Benevolence was \$3,848.00, There were no Memorials for April.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's Report from April was read and approved.

The Total Income for the month was \$ 6,238.00 .

Expenses for the month were \$8,522.82. The larger expenses this month included

Pastor's salary/pension, insurance for the church, 6 month workman's comp., grounds fees, maintenance, and first quarter organist, plus electric, phone/internet. Note: in July the new insurance premium will come out, this may be lower or higher for the upcoming year.

Deacon's Report: Terry has May, Jane has June. Readers are ready for May. Mother's Day Dinner is this Sunday, Served by the Men's Club.

June has Father's Day Brunch and the 170th Celebration of the St. Olaf Parish.

Trustees Report: Josh Fjerstad has agreed to paint the ceiling under the balcony. He will be paid by the hour, as we are all unsure of how big this job might become. He will also spray and paint the stairways outside of the church. This project will begin after Memorial Day.

Education Report: Sunday School is winding down and there will be a pizza and bowling party in Hayfield. The Luther League served at the Ronald McDonald House and the staff was very impressed with our youth.

Parsonage Report: The research, discussions, and feedback about the Parsonage are leaning towards three choices for the congregation; keep it the same, sell it, or remove it. Randy, Pete, Gary, and Bryan are gathering information and cost analysis for the three options. This will be brought to the Joint Meeting in June. Randy and Greg Brandt of West will hold an informational meeting before the Annual Meeting. Any change to the Parsonage will be decided upon by a Congregational Vote.

Old Business: Pete met with KM-Tel and found out that East already is hooked up. We can run the fiber cable to other places in the church if needed. Gina walked through the church and IF the office is moved, she decided the first two Sunday School Rooms would work well for that. Pastor also would like his office in the basement as well, connected to Gina, as they discuss church and communication needs.

New Business:

Council Members are encouraged to think of pros and cons to each Parsonage choice before the June meeting.

Adjournment: Jane Williams made the motion to adjourn the meeting, Jeff Beaver seconded. We ended with the Lord's Prayer.

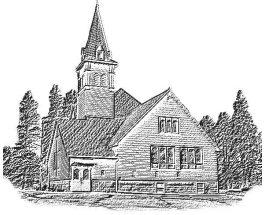
